

Connecting with nature

The <u>DFE climate change strategy</u> has advised that by 2025, all education settings are required to have:

"nominated a sustainability lead and put in place a climate action plan. Pupils are to be engaged in the process of moving towards net zero ... and creating a more biodiverse and less polluted environment in which to learn and connect with nature."

Connecting to nature is a key first step to engaging pupils in conversations around conservation and climate change. Nature connectedness plays a huge role in making us feel happier, more fulfilled, and more able to regulate our emotions, an essential and almost constant function of human life. It is also one of strongest predictors of pro-environmental behaviour.



Wakehurst nature connectedness sessions are designed to improve well-being, reduce stress, and empower participants to take positive action for themselves and for nature.

- Discuss how to adapt the skills learned to their teaching environments to include space for well-being.
- Encourage a sense of belonging to the natural world such that this inspires a sense of stewardship and desire to learn more.
