In response to feedback from headteachers to develop a sustainable model of support, HIAS is pleased to offer a series of Diversity and Equality networks and EARA primary groups for the schools in your area.

This will consist of one network meeting and one EARA meeting per term for each of the districts engaged in the partnerships.

Summer term 2024 – Network meeting + EARA meeting Autumn term 2024 – Network Meeting + EARA meeting Spring term 2025 – Network Meeting + EARA meeting

The focus for the **network** meetings will be 'diversifying the curriculum and environment' which will include an opportunity to review new resources, consider planning exemplars and good practice, and will provide an opportunity to share existing practice with colleagues. These meetings are aimed at the lead practitioner in the school.

The **Equality and Rights Advocates (EARA)** meetings will provide an opportunity for the children to take a lead in promoting Rights and Equality through pupil voice and contribute pro-actively to promoting a more inclusive culture in their schools. These meetings are for four to six pupils with an accompanying member of staff.
