- **'The Sky's the Limit!' - Challenge in EYFS**

This course examines how the adult can facilitate challenge through effective interactions and a high-quality enabling environment

Suitable for: YR Teachers

Dates: Autumn term: eLearning or 17 September 2020*

- **Mixing it up - Taking the EYFS principles into Year 1**

This course will help you understand how the key principles of the EYFS can effectively support a smooth transition and pedagogical approaches to year 1. This will be suitable for Year 1 teachers who require a deeper understanding of the EYFS and how it can meet the needs of this unique cohort who have had reduced learning opportunities in Year R in these unprecedented times. This course also explores provision for mixed YR/1 classes.

Modules will cover aspects such as why play is crucial to young children's learning, the principles of effective EYFS practice, and suggestions on how to design a cross phase curriculum. The final module considers how to meet the needs of children at the point of transition

Suitable for: teachers who are new or developing Y1 and YR/1 practice.

Dates: Autumn term: eLearning or 18 September 2020*

- **Fit to Write' – Physical Development course**

Are your children fit to write?

This course explores the physicality of writing. Discover how physical play supports children on their journey to becoming confident writers. Reflect upon how provision effectively develops the necessary systems within the body required for mark making. Consider how we can support children to develop a dextrous hand and ensure they are fit to write!

Suitable for: Teachers and Practitioners

Dates: Autumn term: eLearning or 24 September 2020*.

- **Ahoy there! Navigating the reading journey**

This course will explore the many elements which go together to help children to not only read, but to do so with understanding and enjoyment. Making phonics (phase 1 Letters and Sounds) fun and immersing children in rich literacy experiences are the focus of this training as well as strengthening knowledge of what comes before reading!

Dates: Autumn term: eLearning or 25 September 2020*.

- **EYFS for NQTs**

This one-day course will provide a basic introduction to all key aspects of the EYFS, with a focus upon the role of the adult, enabling environments and unique child. There will be a strong focus upon ensuring all teachers have a robust and clear understanding of what effective provision and practice look like and how to put it into practice.

This training package was designed for NQTs and teachers returning to the EYFS, however it will also be suitable for Year 1 teachers who require a basic understanding of the EYFS to meet the needs of this unique cohort who have had reduced learning opportunities in Year R in these unprecedented times

Suitable for: NQTs or teachers new or returning to EYFS

Dates: Autumn term: eLearning or 15 October 2020*
