

Remote Learning Curriculum Pack

Guidance

The Remote Learning Curriculum Pack will be launching on the 7th September 2020 to support Primary schools with remote learning in KS1, lower KS2 and upper KS2.

The packs are intended to support pupils at home during the first few days of any isolation period and will supplement any English and maths work given by schools. New curriculum packs, for each age range, will be made available every month. The content will change over the school year to reflect curriculum progression.

It is a creative resource of different activities based on a variety of foundation subjects and linked to the National Curriculum. They will build on existing skills whilst encouraging pupils to demonstrate appropriate independence. Each Key Stage pack will have an overarching theme and the activities are intended to support a short period (1-2 days) of emergency curriculum content whilst schools adapt their current curriculum for remote teaching for the remainder of the period of isolation.

Although suitable for specific Key Stages, the activities can be adapted for the needs of all children.

As many of the activities are practical, feedback could be given using email or photographs as appropriate.

Using the resource

- Each resource contains an overarching theme and most activities relate to this
- There is no time limit to the activities, although each one could take approximately 2 to 3 hours to complete (approximately half a day) and could be spread across a few days if necessary
- Each pack of activities is suitable for the specific Key Stage and will make links to the National Curriculum objectives for those Key Stages
- Pupils could be directed to particular activities or allowed free choice

Rationale

- Activities support specific Key Stages
- Will enable children to work independently
- One or two foundation subjects per pack

Availability

- The packs will be available monthly on the HIAS Moodle
