

Pathway to Progress – A mathematics intervention programme for Year 2 and Year 6 pupils

This practical, interactive, half-day course will support Maths Managers on how to implement ‘Pathway to Progress – A mathematics intervention programme for Year 2 and Year 6 pupils.’

‘Pathway to Progress’ is for pupils who are working below age-related expectations, but are not on the SEND register, and will need additional support to secure the key skills in number and place value and the four operations so that they are able to overcome barriers to learning and make accelerated progress.

Maths Managers will explore the comprehensive teaching tool, with counting starters, worked examples, key questions, language focus and independent practice for each session, considering how they will disseminate to colleagues within school.

Further Information

- The programme works alongside the HIAS schemes of learning and would also complement a blocked unit approach.
- It can be used alongside Diagnostic Mathematics Tasks or classroom AfL to plug gaps and maximise progress in mathematics. This will allow pupils to keep up with peers and age-related learning back in class.
- To keep the momentum of learning, it should be delivered at least three times a week, either 1:1 or in small groups of no more than 3 pupils.
